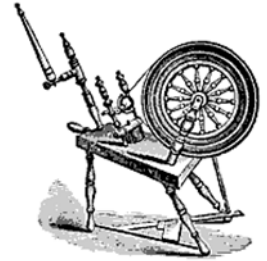

One mile north of Ft Lupton at the N.E corner of Highway 85 and Cnty R 14 1/2 (left at the stoplight, then proceed to second right to Rendezvous Area)

Visit the 1830's Fur Trading Fort, an 1860's Farmhouse and an 1870's One-Room School.



Shoot a Muzzle-loading Rifle, Throw a Tomahawk or Participate in other Skill and Craft Demonstrations. Ride the Stagecoach from the Reenactor's Area up to the Fort.
