

Every Primitive camp has its rules. Here is a list of Tallow River Trapper's 2009 rules, a pre-1840 event.

Anyone camping must be registered and dressed in period clothing. Please share the spirit and wear your primitive attire from the beginning of the rendezvous to the end.

All primitive camps must be kept period correct which means coolers, water jugs and anything modern needs to be covered or hidden from sight. This includes beverage containers.

Dogs and other animals are permitted but must be on a leash. You must clean up after your pet at all times.

If you have an issue with someone or something, find a Dog Soldier. We will resolve any issues in a timely manner. The Dog Soldiers are here to help you. If you need help, look for the red armbands throughout camp.

Because of the high volume of young ears around camp, we ask that there is no swearing or other that is not clean for children's ears or eyes.

No fighting, verbal or physical.

No chain saws. Do not cut live trees. Live trees may not be used as hawk blocks.

Fires in above ground containers only. Minimum of 6 inches above the ground.

All campfires must be attended by an adult. Unattended fires will be put out. You must have a water bucket and a shovel near your campfire.

The range officer has ultimate authority over the gun range. No questions.

Hawk and knife throwing is to be done at the Hawk & Knife Range only. An adult must supervise anyone under the age of 12 at the hawk range.

Haul out your trash. Place ashes from fires in ash barrels provided.

Vehicles are allowed in camp for two hours to unload. Traders are allowed five hours or more if approved by the boosway. Vehicles are not allowed in camp overnight.

NO ILLEGAL DRUGS ALLOWED AT THE RENDEZVOUS. NO UNDERAGE DRINKING.

NO CANNONS in camp – NO CANNONS on the range.

NO FIRING OF ANY BLACK POWDER IN CAMP- THIS INCLUDES GUN SALUTES.
