## TRT Minutes

11-7-09

The TRT meeting was called to order by Captain Michele Cyr at 12:25pm at the Turkey Baster's campout.

Jan Clower read the minutes from the 9-12-09 meeting. Michele Cyr noted one correction and said that the wording was not changed from the camp rules regarding cursing and swearing.
